Volunteer Role Description

Summary: Program Facilitators lead drop-in educational STEAM activities for children between ages 2-6. Program Facilitators encourage interest in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics by leading fun, interactive, and engaging activities on topics related to flight. Volunteers make an amazing contribution to our museum and assist in achieving our vision, mission and goals.

Time commitment: Specified days during the museum's public hours – Monday to Friday, 10:00 am to 5:00 pm and Weekends, 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. Minimum of 25 hours per year.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Deliver program in an educational and interactive format.
- Familiarization with the Alberta curriculum, particularly Grade 6 Science.
- Use appropriate visual and instructional aids to assist with program delivery.
- Respond to student and teacher questions.
- Address feedback or comments from students and teachers.

- A strong interest and understanding of aviation history and technology.
- Dynamic presentation skills for large and small audiences.
- Ability to adapt in a changing environment with frequent interruptions.
- Comfortable working with computers and technology.
- A positive attitude, with strong interpersonal and communication skills.

- Fluency in a second language is an asset.
- Standard First Aid/CPR Level C certification is an asset.
